We are writing to you regarding The Audley at 41-43 Mount Street. As you may be aware an application for planning permission and listed building consent was approved in December 2018. The application was for the continued use of the pub at basement, ground and first floors with visitor accommodation at second to fourth levels. This application was brought forward by the owners, Grosvenor, and some works have commenced on-site.

Artfarm is the independent hospitality and development company that is partnering with Grosvenor to reinvent the Audley site. Our plan is to retain the pub on the ground floor, and restaurant at first floor, with a proposal to transform the upper floors into meeting rooms and dining spaces. Artists will be invited to create site specific commissions which will be displayed throughout the site and there will be a series of programmes aimed at locals and guests which will celebrate and share the stories behind the art and its links to Mayfair and London.

Art and community are central to what Artfarm stands for as a developer. We are known for adapting and reinventing unique sites that come with great stories and we do this by bringing together art, community, education, people and place.
