

Advanced Notice - Scheduled Crane Lifts

- Crane lift No 1 06 February 2021
- Crane Lift No 2 27 February 2021
- Crane Lift No 3 27 March 2021

Mobile crane lifts are arranged to take place on the Saturdays noted above for heavy goods exceeding the maximum load of the hoist. Crane lifts require a temporary road closure and we therefore need to schedule these on the weekend.

On the day of the crane lifts, Balderton Street will be closed with the crane located at the dead-end of Balderton Street. Each crane lift is scheduled to take place from 8am to 6pm. Notification letters in respect of the above crane date will be distributed the week prior. Traffic management will be in place throughout the crane lifts ensuring disruption is minimised.
